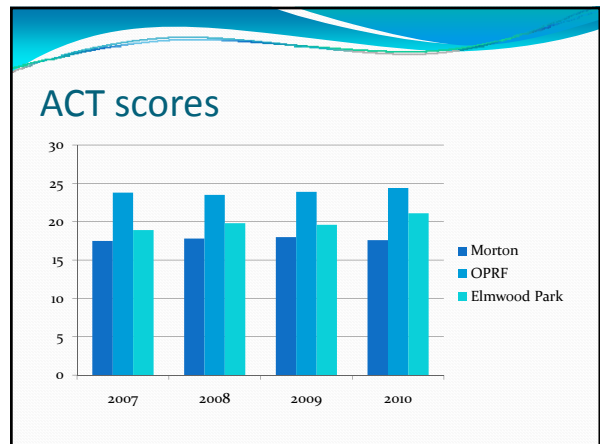
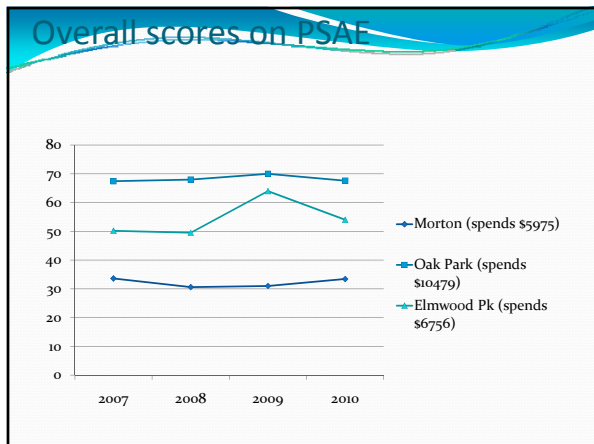


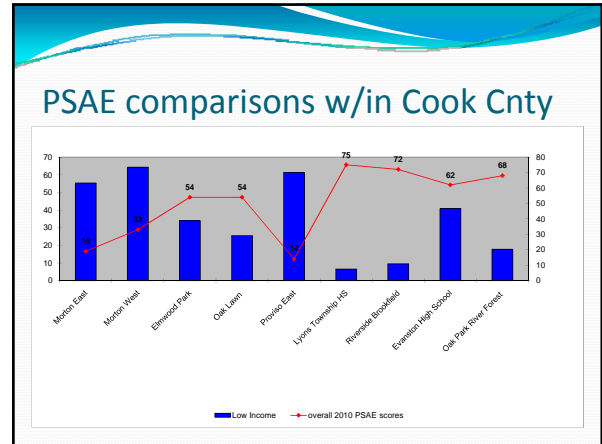
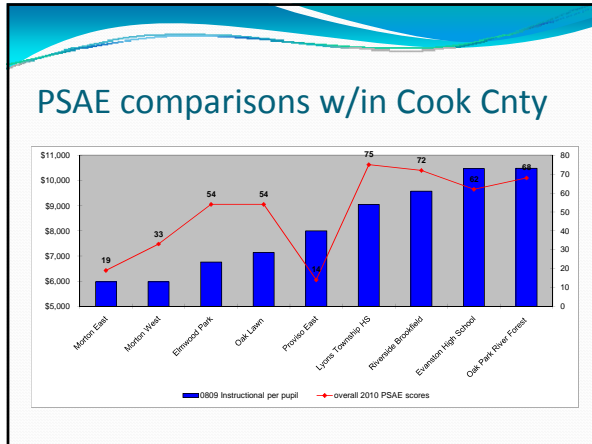
### Are We in The Red??

\*Test scores are ranked 1-4.  
**Level 1=Academic Warning**  
**Level 2=Below Standards**  
**Level 3=Meets Standards**  
**Level 4=Exceeds Standards**

### Who is in the Blue??

\*In 2010 only **2%** of Morton West Juniors exceeded standards. (That is about 14 kids) This compares to about 10% at the state level.  
 \*In 2010 most students (**50%**) were in the “Below Standards” category, some only a few questions from the “Meets Expectations” category  
 \*In 2010 **16.2%** were in the “Academic Warning” category





- ## Questions
- What are the factors that impact student performance on the PSAE
  - Which of those factors are within our control?
  - How much does spending correlate with scores?
  - Absent spending more, what improvements can be made?
  - How will the recent budget cuts (kids taking fewer classes, large study halls w/little teacher resources, etc.) negatively impact student performance on the PSAE and ACT?
  - Is the curriculum aligned with the PSAE? How do you know?
