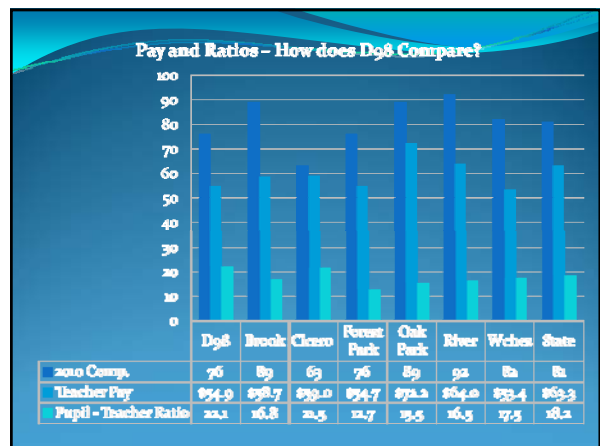
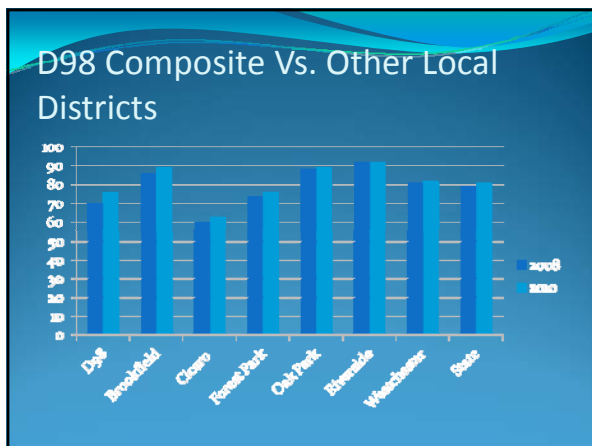
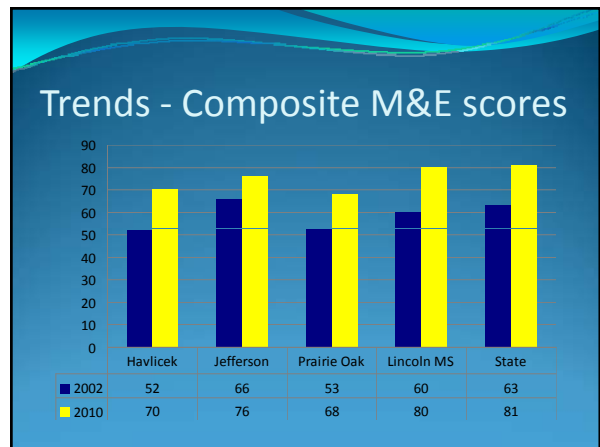


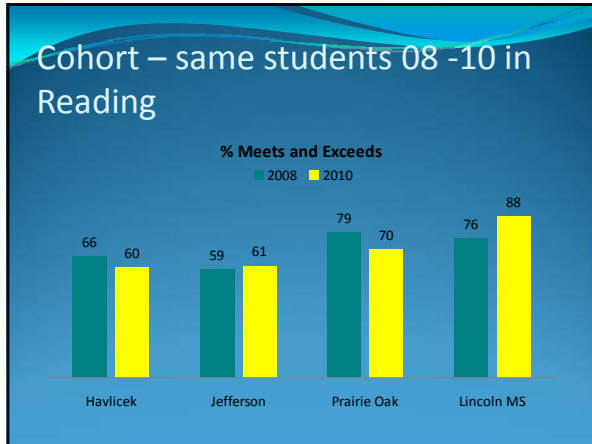
Summary of D98's 2010 ISAT Results

State of the Test Scores Summit - December 2010

- ### District 98
- Four Schools:
 - 3400 students (77% Hispanic)
 - PK*/K-5: Havlicek, Jefferson, Prairie Oak
 - 6th-8th: Lincoln
 - District did not make AYP (overall)
 - Status: AEWS
 - Academic Early Warning Status: Did not make AYP for two consecutive years
 - Eligible for state sanctions

- ### Good news
- D98 met AYP for children receiving special education services
 - Lincoln MS and Jefferson made AYP
 - Gains across the board in “meets and exceeds” numbers
 - Jefferson – best 3rd grade reading scores among D98 and D100 schools – expected to be named “spotlight school”





- ### D98 Strategic Plan
- Calls for 77% Meets and Exceeds across the district in reading and math in 2010
 - Actual scores:
 - Reading – 72
 - Math – 81
 - Sample strategic plan strategies:
 - Extended day, summer school
 - RTI, assessments, curriculum mapping
 - Better communication – website updates
 - Several parent/community advisory committees listed

- ### What does it mean?
- Some gains – but not where we want to be
 - Positive trends at Lincoln and Jefferson, but not at Havlicek and Prairie Oak
 - Key Questions:
 - WHY?
 - Is this enough for our kids?
 - What is the progress on strategic plan initiatives aimed at increasing student achievement?
